To qualify for an Alley Garden Award, the garden must meet all of the following requirements:

- The property must have an easily recognizable house number on the garage (or elsewhere in the alley if there is no garage).
 - The garden must be along the alley and on the alley side of any fence.
 - The alley garden must be weed-free and well-maintained along the entire property line.
 - The alley side of the property must positively contribute to the character and beauty of the alley by being litter free.
 - The garden meets the Beautification Committee's definition of garden as an area of land (which can also be contained within pots) used for the cultivation of flowers, vegetables, herbs, or fruit.
