ACCEPTED ITEMS:

- **New this year: Household hazardous waste (paint, oil, car batteries, etc.)**
- Children's items including books, toys, clothes
- Reusable household goods
- Metals
- Lawn mowers, snow blowers, and other small engines
- Construction debris
- Carpet
- Concrete/rock
- Fluorescent bulbs
- Bikes
- Mattresses/ box springs (**additional fee**)
- Tires (**additional fee**)
- Appliances (**additional fee**) including microwaves, dehumidifiers, water heaters, air conditioners
- Electronics (**additional fee**) including TVs, stereos, phones, computers
- Paper for shredding (**additional fee**)

ENTRANCE FEES:

- \$15 per car
- \$20 per truck, SUV, trailer, minivan, station wagon
- \$30 per larger vehicle

HHW drop-off is free of charge

ADDITIONAL FEES:

Tires: \$2 for car tires, \$3 for truck tires, \$7 for semi tires, \$30 for tractor tires

Mattresses or box springs: \$10 per mattress, \$10 per box spring

Electronics: \$10 per console TV, \$5 per other electronic item, computer keyboard and mouse are free

Appliances: \$15 per air conditioner or water softener, \$10 per other appliance (call JR's at 651-454-9215 for a separate appliance pickup)

Shredding: \$5 for a grocery bag, \$8 for a banker box
