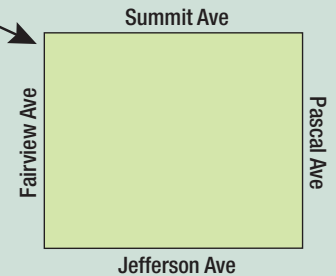
Home Energy

- For a \$30 co-pay, the Home Energy Squad will come to your home to identify your home's energy needs and **install** materials to make it more efficient, bringing over \$400-worth of materials and installation services, which can save you hundreds of dollars yearly.
- **Installations** can include (if applicable):
 - Programmable Thermostat
 - Door Weather-Stripping
 - Compact Fluorescent Light Bulbs
 - Low-flow Showerhead
 - Faucet Aerators
 - Hot Water Heater Blanket
- In addition, when you fill out an information release form, you will receive an **energy use report** for the past year, and periodic updates for the following year.



Composting

- Any Macalester-Groveland resident who attends a workshop will be eligible to purchase a \$45 **discounted backyard composting bin**, and receive information to help get you started making dirt, not waste today!
- If you live in **this area** of Macalester-Groveland, you'll be eligible for a visit from your neighborhood composting team, who will bring up to \$300-worth of information and materials (including a backyard bin) for only a \$20 co-pay!
